Summary

WEB APPLICATION DEVELOPMENT SUPPORT FOR ITER ORGANIZATION

BACKGROUND

The ITER Organization plans to set up a framework service contract to provide support in various software / reporting / database development activities. To establish this framework contract a call for tender is being organized. This call for nomination is the first step in which the ITER Organization seeks nomination of suitable companies. More than one company can be awarded to be part of this framework contract. We plan to select the 3 most suitable companies.

SCOPE OF WORK

The service must be provided at the site of the ITER Organization (St. Paul-lez-Durance, France). We expect that key persons will be able to work at the ITER site for long periods of time (up to 5 years). Replacement of persons providing services for ITER must be agreed by ITER. All persons working for ITER must have a working level on English.

The framework contract will be limited to a maximum amount of 10 FTE per year.

EXPERIENCE

The following skill sets will be required:

User requirement gathering / development follow up / user acceptance test coordination

ASP.NET, VB.NET

MS SQL 2003 / 2008 server

MS SQL reporting server

Java

Various service profiles will be defined:

Senior software engineer experienced with user requirement gathering, development follow up, user acceptance coordination (5 years experience in development or similar)

Senior developer (5 years experience in required field)

Junior developer (2 years experience in required field)

DURATION

The framework contract duration shall be 3 (three) years with an option of extended it once for a period of 2 (two) years; ITER Organization shall establish the request for services on ad hoc basis and relative to the respective annual work plans.

Additional Information

Participation is open to all legal persons participating either individually or in a grouping (consortium). A consortium may be a permanent, legally-established grouping or a grouping, which has been constituted informally for a specific tender procedure. All members of a consortium (i.e. the leader and all other members) are jointly and severally liable to the ITER Organization. The consortium groupings shall be presented at this stage at pre-qualification or at the latest at tender submission. The consortium groupings cannot be modified after presentation without the **prior** approval of the ITER Organization.
