## SUMMARY OF DECISIONS OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE EUROPEAN JOINT UNDERTAKING FOR ITER AND THE DEVELOPMENT OF FUSION ENERGY ('FUSION FOR ENERGY') AT ITS FIRST GOVERNING BOARD MEETING

Barcelona, 28 June 2007

The Governing Board of the European Joint Undertaking for ITER and the Development of Fusion Energy:

- Has adopted unanimously its rules of procedure.
- Has unanimously approved the host agreement between the Joint Undertaking and the Kingdom of Spain.
- Has adopted unanimously transitional measures for financing and other matters.
- Has unanimously approved the rules of procedure for the Executive Committee.
- Has adopted unanimously a decision on the delegation of certain tasks to the Executive Committee.
- Has unanimously approved the vacancy notice for the Director of the Joint Undertaking published in Official Journal of the European Union C 38 A/1 22/02/2007.
- Has adopted unanimously a decision on the terms and conditions for internal investigations in relation to the prevention of fraud, corruption and any illegal activity detrimental to the Communities' interests.
- Has adopted unanimously a decision on confidentiality, independence and managing potential conflicts of interest.
- Has postponed a decision on transparency and public access to the Joint Undertaking's documents to the next meeting.
- Has approved the draft Financial Regulation of the Joint Undertaking.
- Has adopted unanimously a decision appointing the members of the Executive Committee of the Joint Undertaking
- Has decided to extend the deadline for the proposal of candidates for the Scientific Programme Board to the 6 June 2007.

• Has decided to hold an extraordinary meeting on the 17 July 2007.
