# SUMMARY OF DECISIONS OF THE 52<sup>nd</sup> MEETING OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE EUROPEAN JOINT UNDERTAKING FOR ITER AND THE DEVELOPMENT OF FUSION ENERGY ('FUSION FOR ENERGY')

Video Conference Meeting, 5 November 2021

The Governing Board (GB) of the European Joint Undertaking for ITER and the Development of Fusion Energy (Fusion for Energy – "F4E") decided the following:

#### Adoption of the agenda

1. The GB approved the agenda of its 52<sup>nd</sup> meeting.

#### 10th Annual Assessment: Appointment of Experts

2. The GB decided to appoint 4 instead of 3 experts as members of the 10th Annual Assessment panel : i.e. Andreas Jungstand, Andreas Pott, Timo Röcke and Cristel Segers

### Electron Cyclotron Heating System (ECH) Ad Hoc Group (AHG)

- 3. The GB approved the Terms of Reference for the ECH AHG and approved the following composition: Radomir Panel (TAP Chair), Elena Gaio (TAP Vice-Chair), Lena Delpech (TAP Member) and appointed Joerg Stober and Heinrich Laqua as external ECH Experts to be part of this AHG.
- 4. The GB mandated the Bureau to follow up on the work of the AHG and review its conclusions in view of their further transmission to the GB.

#### Vacuum Vessel Status Update

5. The GB took note of the information provided by F4E on the progress of the European Vacuum Vessel Sectors.

#### **Work Programme and Budget Amendments**

- 6. The GB adopted the First Amendment to the 2021 Work Programme, as originally presented to the 50<sup>th</sup> GB meeting.
- 7. The GB adopted the Second Amendment to the 2021 Work Programme.
- 8. The GB adopted the First Amendment to the 2021 Budget, as originally presented to the 50<sup>th</sup> GB meeting.
- 9. The GB adopted the Second Amendment to the 2021 Budget.

10. The GB acknowledged that the approval of 2<sup>nd</sup> amendment of both budget and WP without a prior recommendation by the AMC shall not constitute a precedent.

- 12. The GB approved its summary of decisions.
